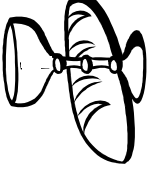


Mother/Daughter Retreat at CFBC

It requires a one month commitment of about an hour a week. Contact Margaret Grassman and let her know which month YOU can commit to! Her cell phone number is 321-543-8161

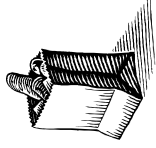

IV. The Example of the Thessalonians, 1 Thess 1:8-10

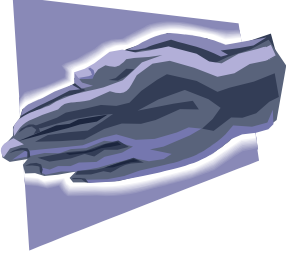
They received the word with conviction, they were models of their faith - they lived what they said they believed! Titus 2:12
